## LASRUG

### Lancaster and Skipton Rail User Group

LASRUG exists to represent present and potential users of the Leeds-Lancaster-Morecambe railway. The line links the towns and cities of West Yorkshire with the city of Lancaster and the seaside resort of Morecambe. It gives access to the southern part of the Yorkshire Dales, and is a vital link for the rural communities along the route. At Leeds and Lancaster, there are main-line connections to all parts of the country, and Carnforth provides connections to the Furness Line and the Cumbrian Coast.

The group was formed in 1989 to support, retain, develop and improve the Lancaster to Skipton line, to encourage greater use of public transport and to press for an integrated rail/road network in the Craven/Lancaster area. Our principal aim is a more frequent train service to accommodate people's business and leisure needs. We also want to see a full Sunday service and more suitable trains on the route.

We do all we can to promote the line and to assist where possible with any problems passengers may have. We work closely with the various local authorities and tourist bodies, with the train operator Northern Rail, and with other rail user groups.
