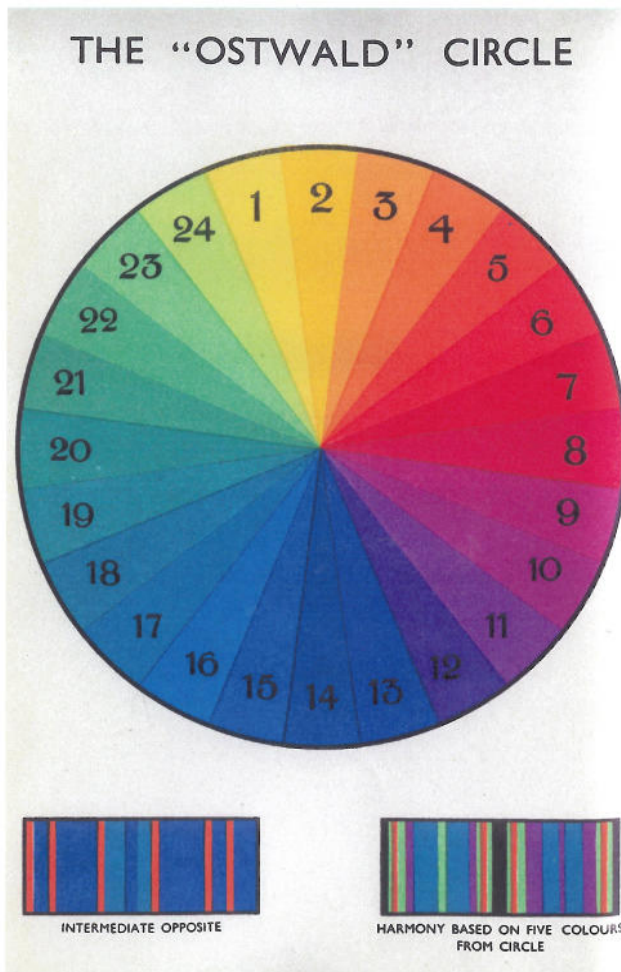

What I will do

- Demonstration of painting a summer deciduous tree
- Images of Hundertwasser - show PowerPoint concentric patterns in paintings of trees
- Image of Colour wheel looking at greens through to yellow

- Q and A harmonious colours
- Harmonies in colour Leaves are green trunks are brown ARE THEY? Trunks are green leaves are brown and how we choose harmonies
- Introduce tertiary colours
- Looking at circles and spirals

What the pupils will do



- Children will watch the demonstration of painting
- Children will watch PowerPoint showing Hundertwasser's work
- Children to use paints and experiment with harmonious colours (green yellows brown maybe)
- At the end of the lesson after break think of an object on the ground flowers in the sky helicopter plane

- Children to know the names of four different greens. Viridian pthalo green Sap green and hookers green indigo

On the day we asked the children if there were any other things they wanted to paint

The point about focussing on colour is to help the children understand the incredible range of colour and to use and recognise more than "red blue and yellow. Children regularly use the colours proper names e.g. turquoise pthalo blue cadmium red hue or burnt umber to describe the colours they require.
