## Welcome to your guide to train services between Ormskirk and Preston.

From Monday 12 December 2011 Northern Rail will be introducing a new timetable featuring an improved service and later evening trains.

Whether you are using the train to commute to work, spending a day visiting friends and family, shopping in Liverpool, Ormskirk or Preston or taking a stroll along one of the canal sidewalks our new regular train service will take you there.

**Anytime Day Return** – valid on any train.

**Off-Peak Day Return** – valid on any train timed to depart from 0900 Mondays to Fridays and at all times weekends and bank holidays.

**Duo** – ticket valid for two adults travelling together returning the same day. Valid on any train timed to depart from 0900 Mondays to Fridays and at all times weekends and bank holidays (not valid weekends during December).

**Weekly ticket** – valid on any train. A valid photocard is required with a weekly season ticket. They can be issued at any staffed station on presentation of a recent passport-sized photograph.

Child discounts are permitted on all fares quoted except for Duo. Railcard discounts apply to Anytime Day Return and Off-Peak Day Return fares, subject to terms and conditions of railcards being met.

## Connections.

Ormskirk – connect with Merseyrail Electrics services for stations to Liverpool Central including Aintree and Maghull.

Preston – connections are available to Blackburn, Blackpool and stations throughout Lancashire, stations within Cumbria, stations to Birmingham, Edinburgh, Glasgow, Leeds, London and York.

## Places to visit using the Ormskirk – Preston line.

**Preston** is the commercial and administrative centre of Lancashire. Preston offers shoppers a superb choice at both the St George's and Fishergate shopping centres; and the old dock is now a picturesque marina including a cinema complex and restaurants.



**Croston** stands on the fast flowing River Yarrow that runs through the village and is spanned by a 15<sup>th</sup> century packhorse bridge. Three churches lie in this picturesque village, which has strong links with agriculture. Church Street has been described as one of the finest examples of a Lancashire village street.

**Rufford** station is on the edge of Rufford village, surrounded by fields. St Mary's Wharf is close to the station, next to the Rufford branch of the Leeds and Liverpool canal, and is well known locally for fine food. There are many attractive walks around the village and along the canal towpath.



**Burscough Junction** offers you easy access to walks along the Leeds & Liverpool canal and the Rufford branch of the canal (turn left at Lathom). Visit the new Burscough Wharf and enjoy exploring the art galleries and specialist shops, [burscough-wharf.co.uk](http://burscough-wharf.co.uk).

**Ormskirk** is a lively market town which combines history and character with excellent shopping and thriving local industry. It's a popular destination, with the bustling Charter Market a magnet for shoppers each Thursday and Saturday.
