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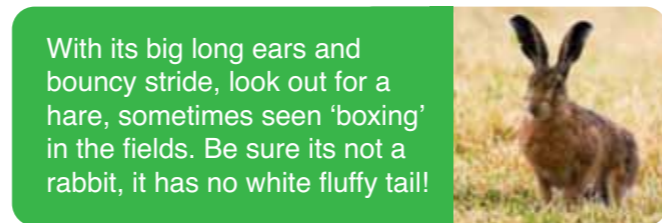


ON THE HUNT...

Can you find the following animals on your journey today?



Spot a male pheasant with his dark green head with red cheeks or maybe you will see a plainer-looking female wandering through the fields.



With its big long ears and bouncy stride, look out for a hare, sometimes seen 'boxing' in the fields. Be sure its not a rabbit, it has no white fluffy tail!



Spot the groups of deer that are often seen beside the tracks, try to spot the stag with his huge antlers or the baby with its white spots.



Where there is water there are often ducks. See if you can spot a male Mallard with his green head, the brown speckled female or maybe even some of their ducklings.



If you're really lucky, you might just glimpse a barn owl or even a bird of prey.

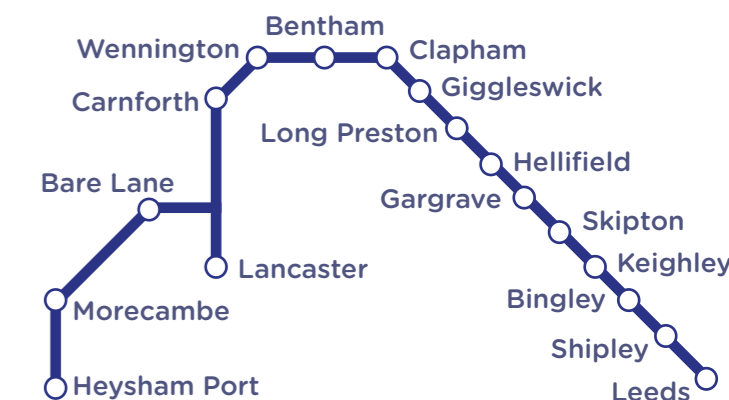

Kirkstall Abbey.
(2 points)



LEEDS



SPY:
The Florentine towers built in the style of the Italian 'Renaissance' - just as you leave the station.
(2 points)

SHIPLEY



SPY:
Shipley Station, it is triangular, with platforms on all three sides.
(1 point)

SALTAIRE



SPY:
The model town of Saltaire with its huge former woollen mill.
(2 points)

BINGLEY



SPY:
The Five Rise Locks on the Leeds-Liverpool Canal high above the railway.
(2 points)

KEIGHLEY



SPY:
The Keighley and Worth Valley Railway platforms and yard at Keighley Station.
(2 points)

SKIPTON



SPY:
Leaving Skipton station spy the train washing facilities which keep carriages clean.
(2 points)

GARGRAVE



SPY:
Whilst the train is at Hellifield station, spy the old Midland Railway iron work with its logos and griffins.
(2 points)

HELLIFIELD



SPY:
If you are sharp-eyed you will spy the dome of the famous Giggleswick School.
(3 points)

LONG PRESTON



SPY:
Pendle Hill in the distance, famous as the home of the Lancashire witches.
(1 point)

GIGGLESWICK



SPY:
Ingleborough, the best known of the Three Peaks.
(2 points)

CLAPHAM



SPY:
The River Lune as you cross it.
(2 points)

BENTHAM



SPY:
At Bentham station, spy a factory that makes firefighting equipment used all over the world. The factory is Art Deco in style.
(1 point)

WENNINGTON



SPY:
Between the disused stations of Arkholme and Borwick, if you are sharp you will spy a farm with the words "GOD IS LOVE" over the barn door.
(3 points)

CARNFORTH



SPY:
West Coast Railways that runs mainline steam trains with engines such as Flying Scotsman. Note all the carriages, and the famous coaling tower.
(1 point)

LANCASTER



SPY:
Entering Lancaster you will cross the River Lune again and have a wonderful view over the city. Spy the domed Ashton Memorial on the horizon.
(2 points)

BARE LANE



SPY:
Lancaster Castle and Parish Church above the station.
(2 points)

MORECAMBE



SPY:
Very briefly at Hest Bank you will catch sight of the sea at Morecambe Bay.
(2 points)
