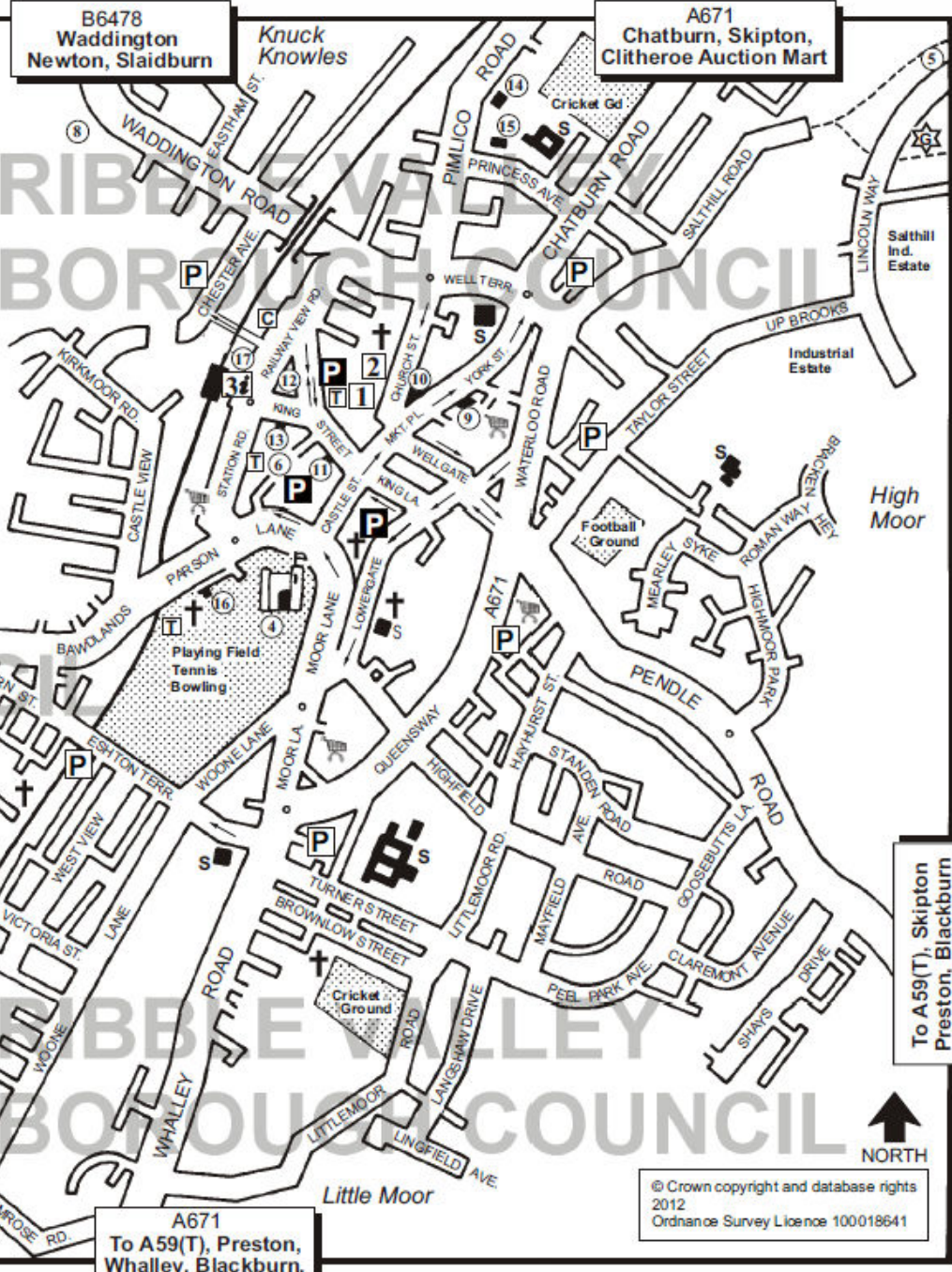

Directions to RVBC offices

From the South (Preston, Blackburn)

Leave M6 at Junction 31. Follow signs for Clitheroe A59 for approximately 13 miles. Straight on at roundabout with MacDonald's. Turn left at next roundabout (A671). Enter Clitheroe. At mini roundabout turn left signed "Town Centre". Straight on at next mini island. Follow one-way system up hill, bearing right at the top of hill by the castle gates. After Barclays Bank on the left, turn left (King St). Take first right (Railway View Ave). Council Offices and car park on right.

From the North (Skipton)

Follow A59. After passing turning for Chatburn/Downham, take the second turning on the right signed "Clitheroe A671". At first roundabout turn left (Chatburn Rd). At next roundabout turn right, then at the following roundabout keep straight on signed "Waddington, Longridge". Follow road around sharp left hand bend - do not follow Waddington Rd under bridge. Take next left turn signed "Town Centre" (one-way). Council Offices and car park on the left.
