

The South Fylde Line's Music Train

The South Fylde Line is proud to announce that it is running a Music Train as part of the St Anne's Music & Arts Festival.

The Festival organisers have managed to secure the services of **Tony Benedict** a locally-based singer of the 'blues' and a well-known 'crooner' to entertain passengers

The Music Train will leave Preston Station just after 5.30pm on Friday 26th July, calling at all stations to Blackpool South and then returning to St Anne's at 6.20pm

Supporters, music lovers and those wanting to do something different can enjoy a shorter journey if they wish by joining the train at St Anne's at 6pm, travel to Blackpool South and then alight at St Anne's station to enjoy other musical events taking place in the town as part of this year's events.

To reach Preston in time for the start of the journey, travellers will have to catch the 16.41 from St Anne's giving time for a coffee or something stronger(!) at Preston Station before the departure of the Music Train at 17.34

Tickets will need to be purchased for the journey preferably from the ticket machines on the stations or from the guard on the train.

The Music on the Train event is in partnership with the Music Festival organisers, Northern Rail, Community Rail Lancashire and backed by the Friends of Station groups along the South Fylde Line.
